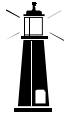

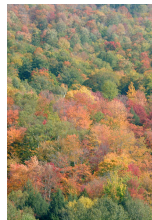

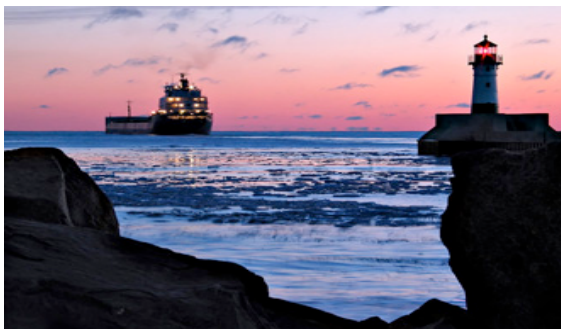

DAY 1: Duluth and the North Shore are tourist destinations year-round, but the first two weeks of October are when visitors are usually treated with a burst of brilliant fall colors. What a perfect time to board our motorcoach and head north. Upon arriving in Duluth, we tour the 39-room **Glensheen Mansion**. This impressive Jacobean-style mansion contains unusual lighting fixtures, custom furniture and fine examples of carved woodwork and stained glass. The grounds feature formal gardens, a lake view and rustic setting. Our hotel is located in the historic Canal Park. A free evening gives us the chance to watch the Aerial Lift Bridge, enjoy the variety of shops and restaurants in Canal Park, and stroll on the Lakewalk, running along the edge of Lake Superior. Overnight - **Duluth, MN**

DAY 2: This morning a **Duluth Guided City Tour** will include **Enger Park and Tower, Leif Erickson Park and Rose Garden** and **Skyline Parkway**, a scenic drive 700 feet above the city with spectacular views of Lake Superior. We visit Duluth's beautifully renovated 1892 depot, home to the **St. Louis County Heritage and Art Center** and its four museums. A large collection of vintage railroad cars and locomotives are displayed at the Lake Superior Railroad Museum. Other museums within the Center have exhibits on Ojibway culture, the history of Duluth and the logging and fur trade. Our fully narrated **Vista Fleet Luncheon Cruise** gives us not only great food, but also close-up views of grain elevators, ore docks and the Aerial Lift Bridge. The **Richard I. Bong WW II Heritage Center** honors WW II participants both at home and on the front lines. Our last stop for the day will be the **Lake Superior Maritime Visitor Center**. Located next to the Aerial Lift Bridge, it has exhibits on the history of the lake and the shipping activity of the Twin Ports. Overnight - **Duluth, MN (B) (L)**

DAY 3: Leaving Duluth this morning, we follow **Minnesota's North Shore Scenic Drive** along Lake Superior. The **Gondola Skyride at Lutsen Mountains** gives us a relaxing treetop-level ride to a point 1,000 feet above the lake. Views from the top include Lake Superior and miles and miles of wilderness. After an included **Lunch**, we tour **Split Rock Lighthouse State Park**, built on the magnificent cliffs above Lake Superior. Sightseeing continues at **Gooseberry Falls State Park** with its five waterfalls. Tonight we can enjoy Canal Park and Lake Superior one last time before having to think about leaving this beautiful port city. Overnight - **Duluth, MN (B) (L)**

DAY 4: Traveling in the direction of home today, we stop at the **Hinckley Fire Museum**. Located in a restored railroad depot, this museum commemorates the firestorm that destroyed the town in 1894. Time will pass quickly on our drive south as we reminisce with our friends about the wonderful time we have had on this tour to Duluth and the North Shore. **(B)**
